

Middle School: Basic Bibliography Guidelines

Citing Print Resources

Book by one Author

Last name of author, First name and Middle initial. Title underlined. City of publication:
Name of Publishing Company, copyright date.

Example:

Sigerman, Harriet. Land of Many Hands: Women in the American West. New York:
Oxford University Press, 1997.

Book with an Editor

Last name of the editor, First name and Middle initial, ed. Title underlined. City of
publication: Name of Publishing Company, copyright date.

Example:

Yolen, Jane, ed. Famous Folktales from Around the World. New York:
Pantheon Books, 1986.

Encyclopedia (signed article)

Last name author, First name. "Title of the article in quotes." Title of the encyclopedia
underlined. City of publication: Name of Publishing Company, copyright date.

Example:

Balgooyen, Thomas. "Falcon." World Book Encyclopedia. Chicago:
World Book, Inc., 2002.

Encyclopedia - Unsigned Article

"Title of the article in quotes." Title of the encyclopedia underlined. City of publication:
Name of Publishing Company, copyright date.

Example:

"Ethiopia." World Book Encyclopedia of People and Places. Chicago:
World Book, Inc., 2001.

Magazine Article-signed

Last name of author, First name. "Title of the article in quotes." Title of the magazine
underlined (space) date of magazine: page numbers.

Example:

Rosing, Norbert. "Walrus." National Geographic Sep. 2001: 62-77.

Magazine Article Weekly-unsigned

"Title of the article in quotes." Title of the magazine underlined (space) day month year
of magazine: page numbers.

Example:

"Passing the Hat." Newsweek 23 Jul. 2001: 8.

Citing Sources from the World Wide Web

Web Page with author

Last name of author, First name. Title of web page. Date accessed <URL>.

Example:

Carlson, I. Marc. Footwear of the Middle Ages. 10 Dec. 2003
<<http://www.pbm.com/~lindahl/carlson/shoehome.htm>>.

Web Page without author

Title of web page. Date accessed <URL>.

Example:

Pyramids: Houses of Eternity. 1 Oct. 2003
<<http://www.ancientegypt.co.uk/pyramids/home.html>>.

Magazine Article-signed

Last name of author, First name. "Title of the article in quotes." Title of the magazine (space) date of magazine. Date accessed <URL>.

Example:

Di Christina, Mariette. "The Eyes Have It." Popular Science Oct. 1999.
18 Dec. 2003 <<http://www.popsci.com/scitech/features/eyes/>> .

Newspaper Article-signed

Last name of author, First name. "Title of the article in quotes." Title of the newspaper (space) date of magazine. Date access <URL>.

Example:

Yoon, Carol Kaesuk. "Struggle to Free an Urban Whale." New York Times 15 Dec.
2003. 18 Dec. 2003 <<http://www.nytimes.com>>.

Image

Title of image. Date accessed <URL>.

Great Blue Heron. 15 Dec. 2003 <http://www.chesapeakebay.net/blue_heron.htm>.

Citing Web Subscription Resources from the Collegiate Paw Page

Encyclopedias-(signed articles)

Last name of author, First name. "Title of article in quotes." Title of encyclopedia underlined. Copyright date. Name of subscription service. Library that provides the subscription. Date accessed <URL>.

Examples:

Asher, Harry. "Photography." Grolier Multimedia Encyclopedia. 2003. Grolier Online. Reed-Gumenick Library. 18 Dec. 2003 <<http://gme.grolier.com>>.

Matzkin, Myron. "Camera." Encyclopedia Americana. 2003. Grolier Online. Reed-Gumenick Library. 18 Dec. 2003 <<http://ea.grolier.com>>.

Hedgecoe, John. "Photography." World Book Encyclopedia. 2003. World Book Online Reference Center. Reed-Gumenick Library. 17 Dec. 2003 <<http://www.worldbookonline.com>>.

Citing Multimedia/CD-ROM Sources

CD-ROM

"Title of the article in quotes" Title of the CD underlined. Copyright date. CD-Rom.

Example:

"Germany." Microsoft Encarta. 2002 ed. CD-ROM.

Video or DVD

Title underlined. Copyright year. Format of film. Distributor.

Example:

The Universe Within. 1995. DVD. WGBH Boston Video.
